## RE: Facility Inspection EOTT Lea Station, GW-351 Lea County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Dann:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) on September 23, 2003, along with Eottenergy personnel Mr. Jeffrey P. Dann, C.P.G. and Mr. Pat McCasland, Environmental Plus, Inc. inspected the EOTT Lea Station. The purpose was pre-approval inspection for the discharge permit for this facility. The information that follows will address the concerns of the OCD at the above referenced facilities.

## Note: For Eottenergy information the OCD has enclosed copies of photos taken during the inspection.

- A. The overall housekeeping and pollution prevention in place at the site was generally fair to prevent discharges to the ground surface. It should be noted, however, some hydrocarbon staining was noted that needs to be addressed for immediate cleanup.
- B. Some empty drums were stored improperly and require correction.
- C. Drums containing liquid were not labeled. Drums containing any material must be clearly labeled.
- D. No facility identifying sign. The facility must be clearly identified showing name of operator and facility name.
- E. Secondary containment structures must be kept clear of sand and debris to prevent overflow in the event of a release.
