The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has received and reviewed the above report submitted on behalf of Plains All American Pipeline, L.P. (Plains) by Environmental Plus, Inc. This report is hereby accepted and approved with the following understandings and conditions:

- 1. Plains will continue to monitor and recover PSH, if present, from impacted groundwater monitoring wells monthly. I monitoring reveals that PSH levels are increasing in any well, then that well will be monitored, and recovery accomplished semi-monthly.
- 2. Plains will continue to sample water from the groundwater monitoring well network quarterly and submit them to an independent, certified laboratory for analysis of BTEX.
- 3. Groundwater samples will be analyzed for PAH annually.
- 4. Plains will install one additional groundwater monitoring well as described in section VII of the report, item #4.
- 5. Plains will submit a 2006 Annual Monitoring Report for this site by April 1, 2007.

NMOCD approval of this report does not relieve Plains of liability should its operations at this site prove to have been harmful to public health or the environment. Nor does it relieve Plains of its responsibility to comply with the rules and regulations of any other governmental agency.
