This document contains Navajo's plan for remediation of a pipeline spill of crude oil in Red Lake Arroyo located in Unit C, Section 29, T17S, R29E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The above referenced work plan is approved with the following conditions:

- Navajo will provide the OCD with a final remediation report upon completion of all 1. remediation activities. The report will contain:
  - A summary of all remedial actions including conclusions and recommendations. a.
  - The results of all soil sampling of the excavation and remediated soils including copies b. of the laboratory analytical results and associated quality assurance/quality control data.
  - A site map showing the locations of all relevant site features, sampling locations and C. the locations of all excavation and remediation areas.
