The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a review of Trico Industries, Inc. July 22, 1994 correspondence, January 31, 1994 REMEDIATION AND CLOSURE REPORT, TRICO INDUSTRIES, OLD ARTESIA SITE, ARTESIA, NEW MEXICO" and October 8, 1993 "REVISED PROPOSAL AND COST ESTIMATE FOR REMEDIATION AND CLOSURE OF THE OLD ARTESIA SITE, ARTESIA, NEW MEXICO". The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) is in the process of reviewing Trico Industries, Inc. July 1, 1993 "PRELIMINARY SITE INVESTIGATION OF THE OLD ARTESIA SITE, ARTESIA, NEW MEXICO" and Trico's accompanying August 16, 1993 correspondence.

The remedial concept for the facility is acceptable. However, the OCD has the following comments and requests for information regarding the above referenced report which must be addressed prior to approval:

- 1. The samples obtained during the investigation were not analyzed for all hazardous waste characteristics. Oil field service company wastes are not exempt from federal RCRA Subtitle C hazardous waste provisions. Therefore, all wastes at the facility must be sampled and analyzed for hazardous waste characteristics. Please provide OCD with analytic results of facility wastes for all hazardous waste characteristics.
- 2. Soils were sampled at only three of the areas identified as containing contaminated soils. All areas with differing sources, including the cesspool, must be analyzed for hazardous waste characteristics. Please submit analyses of these areas to OCD.
