The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed Burlington Resources (BR) April 12, 2000 "HAMPTON 4M – GROUND WATER IMPACT, PROPOSED REMEDIATION PLAN". This document, which was submitted pursuant to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission (OCC) Order R-11134-A, contains BR's proposed plan for additional remediation of source areas and monitoring of contaminated ground water related to BR's operations at the Hampton 4M well site.

The remedial action plan as contained in the above referenced document is approved with the following conditions:

- 1. BR will notify the OCD at least 1 week in advance of scheduled activities such that the OCD has the opportunity to witness the events and/or split samples.
- 2. BR will include the results of all source remediation actions in the annual report to the OCD.
