The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a review of the following documents submitted by Tierra Environmental Company, Inc. on behalf of the Gary Williams Energy Corporation:

- 1. October 13, 1993 "GARY WILLIAMS ENERGY TANKER ACCIDENT AND RESULTING CRUDE OIL SPILL, OCTOBER 8, 1993, AT MILEPOST 287, HWY 84, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO 93060".
- 2. October 14, 1993 "TANKER SPILL EMERGENCY RESPONSE & REMEDIATION, MILE POST 287, NEW MEXICO HWY 84, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO".
- 3. November 16, 1993 "CERTIFICATE OF WASTE STATUS NON-EXEMPT OILFIELD WASTE".
