RE: CORAL #2 GROUND WATER CONTAMINATION

Dear Mr. Stickland:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed Kimbell Oil Company of Texas's (KOCT) August 22, 1995 "GROUND WATER CONTAMINATION, KIMBELL OIL COMPANY OF TEXAS, CORAL #2 (UNIT M, SECTION 27, T25N, R06W)". This document contains KOCT's plan for remediation of contaminated soils and ground water at the Coral #2 well site.

The above referenced plan is approved with the following conditions:

- 1. The OCD defers comment on the placement of additional monitor wells to determine the extent of ground water contamination pending the results of the excavation actions. Please be aware that the OCD will require that additional investigation actions be taken if the horizontal extent of contamination is not defined.
- 2. Ground water and soils will be sampled and analyzed using EPA approved methods.
- 3. KOCT will submit a remedial action report to the OCD by July 1, 1996. The report will contain:
  - a. A description of all activities which occurred during the previous year, conclusions and recommendations.
  - b. A summary of the analytical results of all quarterly sampling. The laboratory results for each monitoring point will be presented in tabular form and will show all past and present sampling results.
  - c. The composition, concentration and application rate of all materials used to enhance biodegradation of contaminants.

- 4. KOCT will notify the OCD at least 48 hours in advance of all major scheduled activities such that the OCD has the opportunity to witness the events and/or split samples.
- 5. All original documents submitted for approval will be submitted to the OCD Santa Fe Office with copies provided to the OCD Aztec District Office.

Please be advised that OCD approval does not relieve KOCT of liability if contamination exists which is beyond the scope of the work plan or, if the activities fail to adequately remediate or define the extent of contamination related to KOCT's activities. In addition, OCD approval does not relieve KOCT of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state or local laws and/or regulations.
