In response to your request, one Meridian well was included in the Olson report. The Grambling A3A was examined in the William Olson <u>Investigation of Volatile Organic Contamination in</u> <u>Ground Water at Unlined Produced Water Pits</u>. As part of Meridian's standard maintenance procedures, the equipment at this well site has been inspected, repaired or replaced, and painted. The well pad has been cleaned and leveled. The earthen pit on the location was replaced with a below grade 55 BBL fiberglass pit with leak detection. The earthen pit was excavated to receive the fiberglass pit, and all excavated material was thin spread on the well site.


