The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a review of Nassau Resources November 16, 1993 correspondence and Nassau Resources October 1993 "ELIMINATION OF HYDROCARBON EXPOSED SOIL" which was submitted to OCD on October 25, 1993. These documents contain information related to the soil and water remedial actions at the Nassau Resources John A. Brimhall #1 well site.

The soil remediation work performed appears to have adequately remediated the source area in accordance with the standards in effect at the time of closure. The ground water monitor well installation and monitoring recommendations contained in the above referenced documents are approved with the following conditions:

- Nassau Resources will contact the OCD for approval of the disposal of all wastes generated during the project prior to disposal.
- 2. Ground water quality sampling of the monitor wells will include laboratory analysis of concentrations of polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) using appropriate EPA laboratory methods.

(Note: Because New Mexico does not have a ground water standard for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH), the OCD does not require that ground water be analyzed for TPH)

- 3. Nassau Resources will submit a quarterly report to the OCD containing the results of all quarterly sampling and a water table elevation map. The first quarterly report will also contain the final monitor well construction schematics for each monitor well. Quarterly reports will be submitted on March 1, June 1, September 1, and December 1 of 1994.
- 4. Nassau Resources will contact the OCD at least 72 hours in advance of all scheduled activities such that the OCD may have the opportunity to witness the events and/or split samples.
