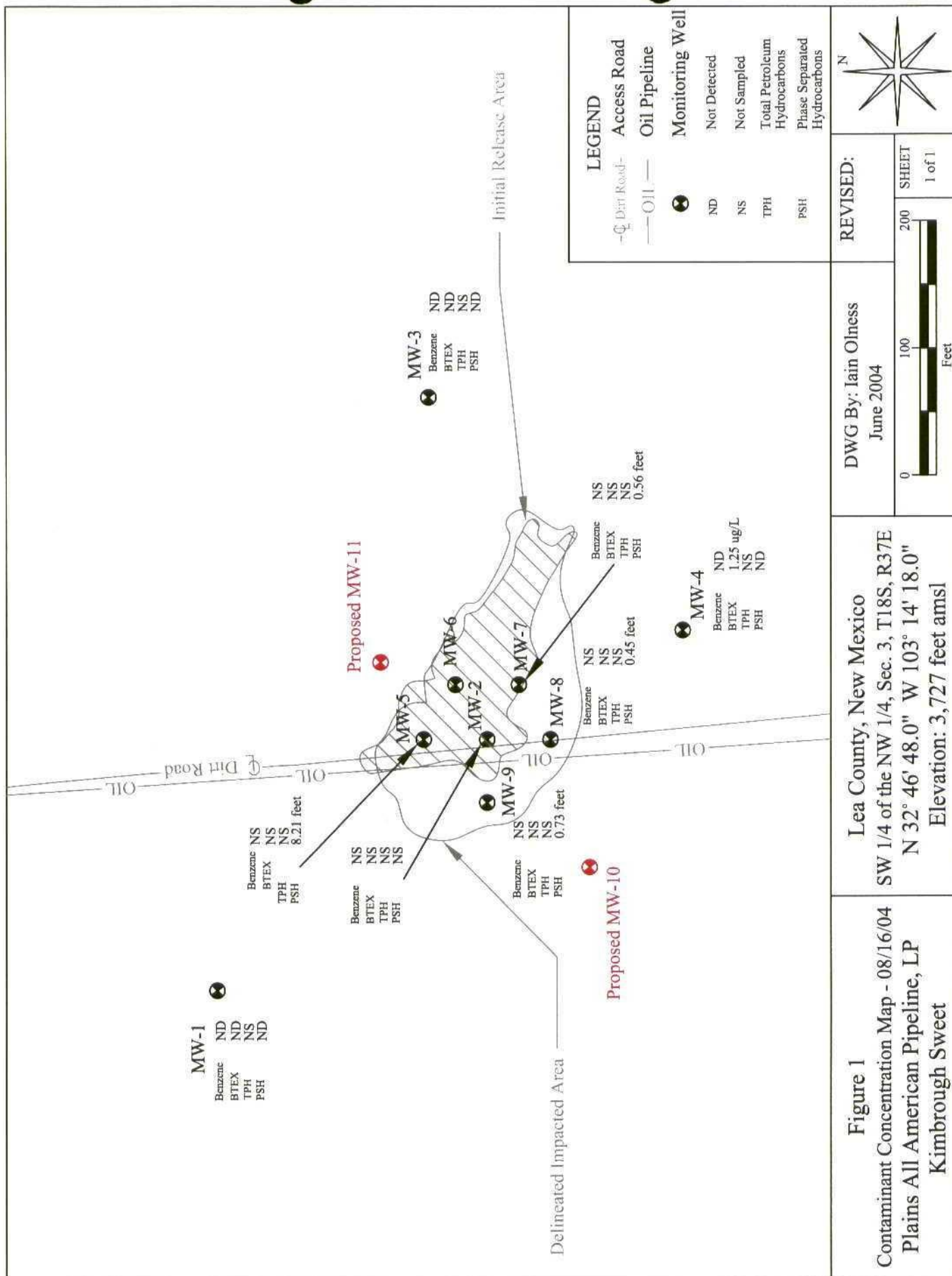

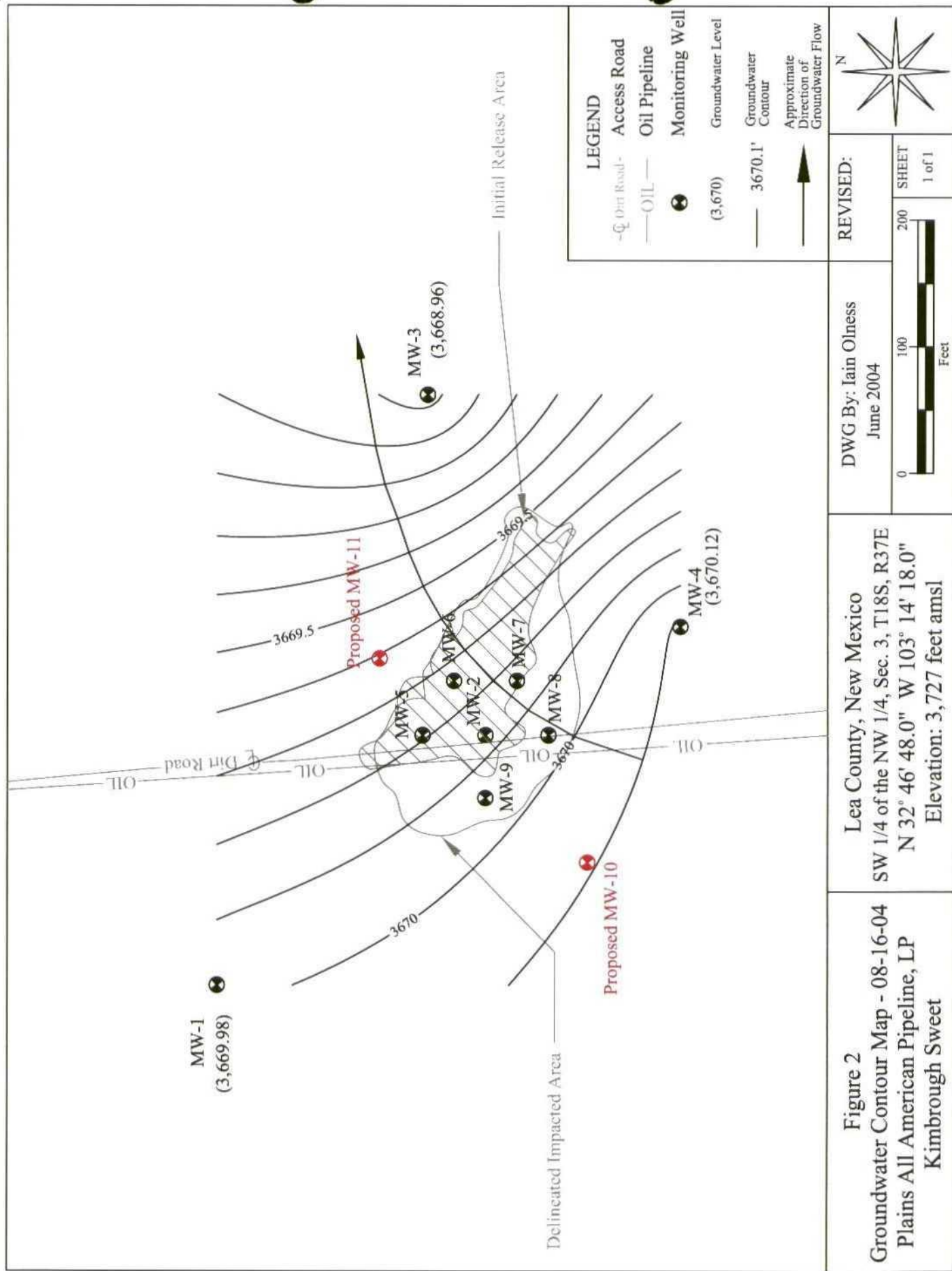

Environmental Plus, Inc.(EPI), 1324 N. Main Street, Eunice, New Mexico, on behalf of E.O.T.T. Energy Pipeline submits this written notification of ground water impact due to a crude oil leak on the Kimbrough Sweet 6" Line, in the Unit G Section 3, T18S, and R37E in excess of 20 NMAC 6.2.3103, i.e., "Non-aqueous phase liquid shall not be present floating atop or immersed within ground water, as can be reasonably measured." This submittal follows the immediate verbal notification earlier on March 5, 2001 and is consistent with the notification requirements of 19 NMAC 15.116.

Distribution of the crude oil source term at the site is currently being assessed and there are no domestic, agricultural, or public supply wells within 2000' of the site. A remediation work plan addressing soil and ground water will be developed and submitted for your consensus.
