Re: Application for a non-standard gas proration unit, Cities Service Oil Company's State "AO" lease, Eumont Gas Pool, Sec. 2-21S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

The Cities Service Oil Company makes application under Rule 5(b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, contained in Order R-520, for a non-standard gas proration unit and wishes to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of an oil and gas lease known as the State "AO" and located in Section 2-215-36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. The State "AO" lease covers that area 2570' of the North Line and 2640' of the East Line of Section 2, which section is approximately  $l_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$  miles in a North-South direction and 1 mile in an East-West direction.

3. The drilling of a gas well located 1910' from the North Line, 1980' from the East Line of Section 2-215-36E is now in progress. This well is projected to the Queen formation and will be in the Eumont Gas Pool as defined in Order R-520.

4. The applicant proposes that the State "AO" lease be established as a non-standard gas proration unit of 160 acres.

5. All requirements of Rule 5(b) are complied with by this well. Waivers have been mailed to all operators owning interests in Section 2-21S-36E with a request that they be submitted to the Conservation Commission.

6. There is attached to this application a plat showing the location of the proposed unit and the other tracts in Section 2-215-36E.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Commission grant the applicant permission to establish this non-standard gas proration unit in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of The Commission.
