Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Arrow Gas Pool consisting of the N/2 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage was to have been assigned to your William A. Ramsay "B" Well No. 2, located 660' from the West line and 1980' from the North line of Section 25.

Order R-520, Rule 5 (a) paragraph 3, clearly limits, as to the well location, the number of acres that can be assigned a non-standard gas proration unit. This office is unable to grant approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for the above mentioned well of over 160 acres because of the said well's location to its West and South boundaries.
