Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre nonstandard gas provation unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Twp. 25 South, Rge. 37 East, NMPM S/2 SE/4, NE/4 SE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 of Section 6.

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your C. D. Woolworth, Group 3 Well No. 2, located 1963' from the North line and 643' from the East line of Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
