Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company's C. D. Woolworth Group 3, Well No. 2, located 1963' from the north line and 643' from the east line of Section 6, Township 25S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed as an oil well in the Seven Rivers Formation on April 3, 1939.

It is our intention to plug this well back to a depth of 3100' and perforate the Yates Gas Zone from 2900'-3050' thus re-completing the well as a gas producer in the Yates sand. This letter constitutes an application to form a non-standard gas proration unit attributable to this well as provided by New Mexico Oil Conservation Order No. R-520, Case No. 673, effective August 12, 1954. This proposed non-standard gas unit will comprise the S/2 SE/4, NE/4 SE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 of Section 6, Township 25S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on the attached plat.


