Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
N/2 N/2 of Section 18

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your American-National-Keohane Unit Well No. 1, to be drilled at a location 660 feet from the North line and 2200 feet from the West line of Section 18, in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 18, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as you furnished waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
