Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
NE/4, N/2 SE/4, & SW/4 SE/4 of Section 29

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Jack A-29 Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of Section 29, in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 29, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 280 acres.
