Gentlemen:

On February 7, 1955, Gulf Oil Corporation made application to the Oil Conservation Commission for approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit covering Gulf's Theodore Anderson Lease located in the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Maxico. On April 13, 1955, the Commission issued Adminstrative Order NSP 105 granting this non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool, and the Theodore Anderson Well #1 was designated as the Unit Well.

Now Gulf Oil Corporation and Tide Water Associated Oil Company have agreed to enter into a unit for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool gas underlying the SE/4 of Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, pending the approval of a 160-acre nonstandard gas proration unit.

In view of the foregoing, Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SE/4 of Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its Theodore Anderson Lease located in the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Maxico. Tide Water Associated Oil Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease located in the N/2 of said quarter section. These two leases comprise the 160 acres above described.

(2) Gulf Oil Corporation's Theodore Anderson #1 located 1980 feet from the east line and 660 feet from the south line, Section 8, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was dually completed March 25, 1955, in the Eumont Gas Pool and the Monument Oil Pool, and has been producing Eumont gas since June 3, 1955. Gulf and Tide

Water have agreed to use this as the Unit Well, effective upon the date of approval of the Conservation Commission.

- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
  - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
  - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
  - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
  - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
  - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interests in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation and Tide Water Associated Oil Company to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.


