Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the SW/4 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's E. Shipp "B" Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 8. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas proration unit was filed and by your Administrative Order NSP-181 you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with pool rules based upon a unit of 160 acres.

W. Kutter "D" (State) 80-acre Lease described as the S/2 SW/4 Section 8 and 80 acres of applicant's E. Shipp "B" Lease described as the N/2 SW/4 Section 8, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant will endeavor to communitize the royalty interests in these two leases upon receipt of the Oil Conservation Commission's approval of such unit. (2) Applicant intends to recomplete the E. Shipp "B" #1 which is located 660 feet from the west line and 1980 feet from the south line Section 8, T-19-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, to provide the unit well for producing gas from the Queen Formation underlying the proposed unit. The attached plat shows the well location, lease ownership within the section on which the proposed unit is located and ownership of acreage contiguous to such section. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows: (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.

- (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- (e) By copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation to form the proposed non-standard gas proration unit. (See attached affidavit.)

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas proration unit.


