The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a review of Williams Field Services' (WFS) July 2, 2001 "ALBRIGHT #4 DRIP PIT REMEDIATION AND CLOSURE REPORT". This document contains a "PIT REMEDIATION AND CLOSURE REPORTS" for an unlined pit in the San Juan Basin at which ground water contamination was discovered. The document requests closure of the site since ground water has been remediated to below New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) standards as demonstrated in 4 consecutive quarterly sampling events. The document also proposes to plug and abandon the site ground water monitoring wells.

The pit closure/remediation activities and proposed monitor well plugging and abandonment for the site listed below are approved on the condition that that the monitor wells are plugged and abandoned by cutting the casing off below ground surface and filling the annulus from bottom to top with a cement grout containing 3-5% bentonite.

1. Albright #4 (Drip pit)

Unit F, Sec. 22, T29N, R10W.
