1RP-5512 is for OXY's Lovington Trust East Oil Tank, opened under API # 30-025-22550 (Lea County – District 1), so has nothing to do with the DiMaggio. After some research, I did find the email you sent with the DiMaggio 3 flowline release. It was sent to me and 5 other people copied, however, the District 2 Environmental Specialists were not copied. It looks like I didn't notice they weren't copied and moved the email into a folder, thinking it would be processed by the environmental folks. My fault for not looking a little closer, however, anything environmental for District 2 MUST be sent to Rob Hamlet and Victoria Venegas. You may continue to copy me, but that will possibly go away soon, so be sure everything gets to Rob & Victoria.

I will get the initial C-141 processed and get you the RP number as soon as we have it. Meanwhile, you are approved for a 30 day extension for submission of the closure report for the DiMaggio 3 release. (Due 9/25/19).

Mike,

The Dimaggio 003 release site (1RP-5512) was fully delineated and excavated within 90 days of the spill date, and no remediation plan was submitted. However, due a lack of equipment availability, we were not able to backfill and complete the site within that same time frame. Since the work is essentially completed, on behalf of OXY, I hereby request a waiver of the work plan and a 30-day extension or grace period to finalize the site and submit a closure report.

Also, I am unable to find the initial C-141 and 2RP # for this release in the NMOCD's imaging system. The C-141 was submitted with my email below from 5/31. Will you send me that 2RP # when you get an opportunity?

This is to inform you that OXY Permian had a reportable release in Eddy County on 5/22/2019. Details below:

- **Site Name:** Dimaggio 0003 Flowline
- **Release Location:** Unit Letter "O" (SW/SE), Sec. 16, T 26S, R 29E
- **Release Volume:** 4 bbls of crude oil and 4 bbls of produced water
- **Recovered:** 0 bbls
- **Cause of Release:** Pipe fatigue in a section of a 4-inch poly production flowline
- **Approximate Area impacted by release:** 30' x 30' (measurements are subject to change with GPS tracking)
- **GPS Coordinates and Driving Directions:**
 - 32.04217,-103.98561
 - From NM-285 & Whitehorn Rd, go E on Whitehorn Rd approximately 2.45 miles. Stay L at Y, go approximately 4.05 miles. Turn W, go 0.3 miles to Dimaggio 0001 location. Release site is in pasture, approximately 250 yards north of location.
