The OCD has approved the Site Characterization and Remediation Plan for incident # NRM2004437525 with the following conditions:

- The SP4 area will need to be remediated to greater than 1 foot below ground surface.
- Confirmation samples will be collected as composite samples, representing an area of no
 greater than 200 square feet for floor samples and sidewall samples. At a minimum, at least
 one sidewall sample will need to be collected from each wall of the excavation. Individual grab
 samples will be collected from any wet or discolored areas.
