On behalf of XTO Energy, please see the attached closure report for the Big Eddy Unit 039 (2RP-5294). It has been uploaded to the NMOCD permitting portal (PO# 4TAYT-191025-C-1410).

BLM Summary:

XTO originally submitted a deferral report after excavating impacted soil from around a production tank, but leaving some material in place around the tank. NMOCD denied the deferral request based on potential shallow groundwater. XTO drilled a soil boring and encountered fluid less than 50 feet deep. Accordingly, XTO removed the tank and excavated the remaining impacted material. A total of approximately 130 cubic yards of impacted soil was excavated from the Site. Laboratory analytical results for the initial excavation and the confirmation floor sample from the final excavation indicated that benzene, BTEX, TPH, and chloride concentrations were compliant with the Closure Criteria and no further excavation was required. The excavation will be backfilled and recontoured upon approval with additional pictures provided documenting the backfill work.
