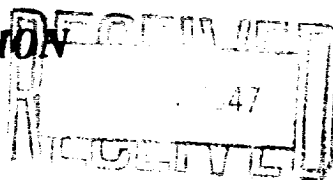

Work was delayed and afterward decision was reversed to satisfaction of all concerned. It was decided to attempt to cement the last string of casing, which was 5 1/2" O.D., to shut off water and test formations below; 10 sacks of cement were placed behind pipe at 1593' on date of August 8th, 1947, and awaiting results of which the Commission will be notified.

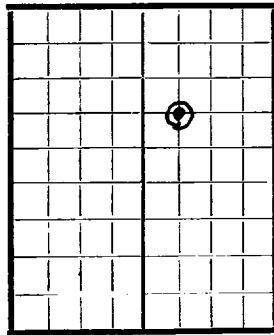
