Attached in duplicate (to each office) are a well location plat (C-102) with an ownership plat for the above referenced well.


Due to steep topography, cliffs and an archaeological site to the east, this location does not meet state spacing requirements. This is the only geologic and topographic site acceptable.






Vicinity Map for
