Dear Mr. Oberding:

At the request of Jay Management, LLC (Jay Management), Timberwolf Environmental, LLC (Timberwolf) prepared this notification of completed remedial actions to remedy impacted soils at the New Mexico BB State No. 1 Tank Battery ('Site'). The Site is located approximately 5.5 miles northeast of Caprock, New Mexico (Figures 1-3).

On 01/23/15, approximately eight (8) barrels (bbls) of crude oil and produced water were released due to a produced water tank overflowing. All released fluids were contained within the firewall. A vacuum truck recovered five (5) bbls of fluids on the same day of release.

Jay Management contractors excavated approximately 24 cubic yards of impacted soil from inside the tank battery on or about 02/20/15. Excavated soils were trucked and disposed at a permitted commercial landfarm in Caprock, NM. Clean fill was used to replace the excavated soil. Work conducted is documented in the attached Form C-141 and Photographic Documentation.






