Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A four inch pipeline located near the wellhead ruptured approximately 10 feet below ground surface. The line was uncovered by excavation and repaired upon discovery.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Impacted soil was excavated and disposed of in a landfill. A 20 mil liner was placed in areas where chloride concentrations extended deeper than 4 feet below ground surface. The excavated area was backfilled with cleans soil and revegetated.
