**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\***

Because a pinhole leak was discovered in a produced water transfer line from the North Gaucho pond to the Black Mamba 15 State Com 8H while prefilling frac tanks, the pumps were shut down and line clamps were installed to isolate a small section of the line to be repaired. When the line was cut to make repairs, the head pressure on the line was high enough that the line clamps were not able to hold all the pressure back, resulting in a release of produced water. Once the pressure was low enough, the line clamps held and repairs were able to be made.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\***

The spill area affected is approximately 8' x 100' x 2" deep following an existing 2-track in the field approximately 4.37 miles northeast of the Black Mamba 15 State Com #8H. Approximately 35 barrels of produced water was spilled and none was recovered, all water soaked into the sand. An environmental company has been called to test and create a remediation plan for submittal.
