This release was caused when a construction crew installing a new flowline cut into the SWD line. A vacuum truck was dispatched to recover all standing fluid.

This release occurred within the containment and on the backside of the battery. This release did not impact the pasture but remained on location. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
