

Shelly, it was 100% contained in the firewall. Also, you are correct, this is private surface. But we will need permission to report this oil as an unavoidable loss for royalties...but we have to receive BLM permission to do this.

1 advanced 2 borings with my hand auger and collected samples at surface, 1, and 2 feet. 1 am running the surface for chlorides only. 1 am running the other samples for BTEX/TPH, but I am holding the 2 foot samples in case I do not have to run them.

Based on my sampling: First 2 to 3 inches is heavily stained. Soils at 1 foot have no staining, but heavy odor. Soils at 2 feet do not have odor.

There are no houses or surface water nearby. The nearest water well is 0.5 mile to the south and the depth to water is shown by the state engineers office to be 110 feet below surface. With these data we should be looking at 5,000 mg/kg TPH. As soon as I have the lab report, I will submit a formal plan.
