Please remember to include this 1RP identifier to all communications. Also, please be advised that a release characterization/delineation workplan as detailed in the attachment must be approved by NMOCD BEFORE any remediation work.

Please note that there is a USGS-identified surface waterbody approximate 500 ft. East of the well. Also, soil temperature of samples submitted for laboratory analyses on August 28, 2017, is not optimal.

Vertical delineation is considered complete for 1RP-4880 with these conditions for the proposed remedial activities:

- 1. B-1 represents a large area and chloride levels at 5 ft. bgs exceed permissible 600 mg/kg. A minimal 20 mil liner is required for the entire patch represented by B-1 at the bottom of the proposed 3 ft. excavation. Confirmation sidewall samples at 1.5 ft. are required.
- 2. Confirmation sidewall samples at 2 ft. bgs are also required for the area represented by B-2 and B-3.
- 3. For the area represented by B-4, confirmation bottom samples at the proposed 2 ft. excavation are required. If samples exceed 600 mg/kg chlorides, excavate to the next foot.
- 4. Confirmation bottom and sidewall samples should be no greater than 50 ft. apart.
- 5. An appropriately scaled map is required with 1) the bottom and sidewall confirmation sample locations marked with GPS coordinates; 2) the liner dimensions and depth of the excavated areas annotated; and 3) each area clearly outlined.

Please confirm or inform if clarification is required. Like approval from NMSLO is required. NMSLO may have additional requirements and stipulations.
