Closed Loop Drilling System

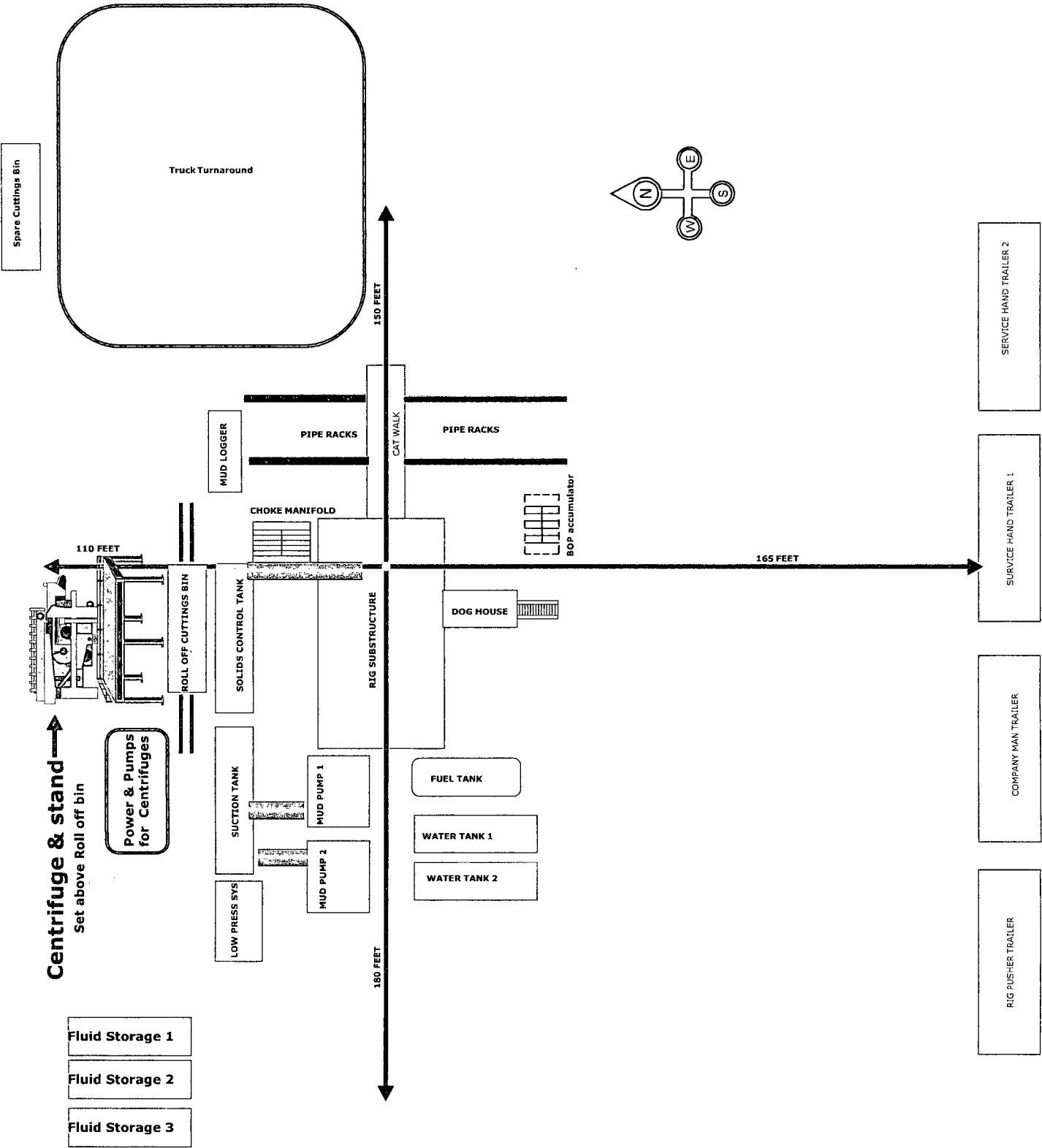
Operations and Maintenance Plan

Closed Loop equipment will be inspected and monitored closely on a daily basis by each drilling rig Tour and by those hired specifically to operate the equipment. Any leak or release detected will be repaired immediately and the proper NMOCD official will be notified within the 48 hr requirement. A large release will require Caza Operating, LLC representatives to contact NMOCD immediately at the Hobbs office 575 393 6161 as stated by NMOCD rule 116.

Closure Plan

During and after drilling operations, liquids (which apply), all drill cuttings and drilling fluids will be hauled and disposed of at the R-360 disposal (permit number NM-01-0006) located about 30 miles East of Carlsbad, New Mexico. An alternate approved disposal site has been selected Parabo "Sundance" disposal (permit number NM 01-0003) which is 3 miles East of Eunice, NM. The Second site would only be used in the event of problems with CRI disposal.
