Drill Site/Roads (Rule 114)

Comments on Inspection: Field inspection of drilling pits and location showed oil, hoses, and other debris in pits. RULE 19.15.17.12.B requires that any oil should be removed immediately. OPERATOR SHOULD REMOVE ALL OIL, HOSES, PALLETS, CANS OR OTHER DEBRIS, FROM OUTER AND CENTER HORSEHOE AREAS OF PIT AND DE-WATER PITS. Operator has also failed to submit the required sundry notices for drilling operations. OPERATOR SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING: 1) SEPARATE C103's CONTAINING INFORMATION ON EACH STRING OF CASING, CEMENTING, AND PLUGGING. 2) A C105, 3) A DIRECTION SURVEY, AND 4) A COPY OF ANY LOGS THAT WERE RUN. 1ST NOTICE.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well.

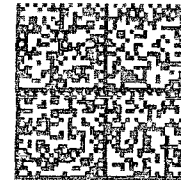
