Gathering System and Pipeline Notification

Well(s) will be connected to a production facility after flowback operations are complete, if gas transporter system is in place. The gas produced from production facility is dedicated to <u>Enterprise Field Services, Lucid Energy, Enlink Midstream,</u> <u>Energy Transfer Company</u> and will be connected to <u>EOG Resources</u> low/high pressure gathering system located in Eddy/Lea County, New Mexico. EOG Resources provides (periodically) to <u>Enterprise Field Services, Lucid Energy,</u> <u>Enlink Midstream, Energy Transfer Company</u> a drilling, completion and estimated first production date for wells that are scheduled to be drilled in the foreseeable future. In addition, EOG Resources and <u>Enterprise Field Services, Lucid Energy,</u> <u>Enlink Midstream, Energy Transfer Company</u> have periodic conference calls to discuss changes to drilling and completion schedules. Gas from these wells will be processed at <u>Enterprise Field Services, Lucid Energy</u>, <u>Transfer Company</u> Processing Plant located in <u>Lea</u> County, New Mexico. The actual flow of the gas will be based on compression operating parameters and gathering system pressures.

Flowback Strategy

After the fracture treatment/completion operations, well(s) will be produced to temporary production tanks and gas will be flared or vented. During flowback, the fluids and sand content will be monitored. When the produced fluids contain minimal sand, the wells will be turned to production facilities. Gas sales should start as soon as the wells start flowing through the production facilities, unless there are operational issues on <u>Enterprise Field Services, Lucid Energy, Enlink Midstream,</u> <u>Energy Transfer Company</u> system at that time. Based on current information, it is **EOG Resources'** belief the system can take this gas upon completion of the well(s).
