Ran 219' of 2-5/8" 80# Seamless H-40 casing and set at 233'. Cemented with 250 sacks of Neat and circulated 30 sacks. Tested pipe and casing seat with 800 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement on March 10, 1955, and both held OK.
