DETAILS OF WORK

Total Depth 3038 in sandstone. Run 77 1/3 joints (3025') 5 1/2" @ 14# GR J-55 SS casing set at 3033' and cemented with 300 sacks neat cement. Plug was down at 12:40 P.M. 9-17-54. Cement was allowed to set while rotary was moved off and drilling unit moved in. Water shut-off test was made September 22, 1954 and results were satisfactory. Drilling resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
