Gentlemen:

Attached is a C-101 for the drilling of our Williams No. 1 in the Drickey-Queen area.

It is our understanding that a wildcat location must be drilled in the center of a 40 acre tract. Due to topographical conditions occasioned by the Caprock, we will be forced to drill the well 1980 feet from the north line and 2310 from the west line.

We have discussed this problem with Mr. S. J. Stanley, Engineer, and he has concluded that the Commission should waive the 660 footage rule on an undesignated well.

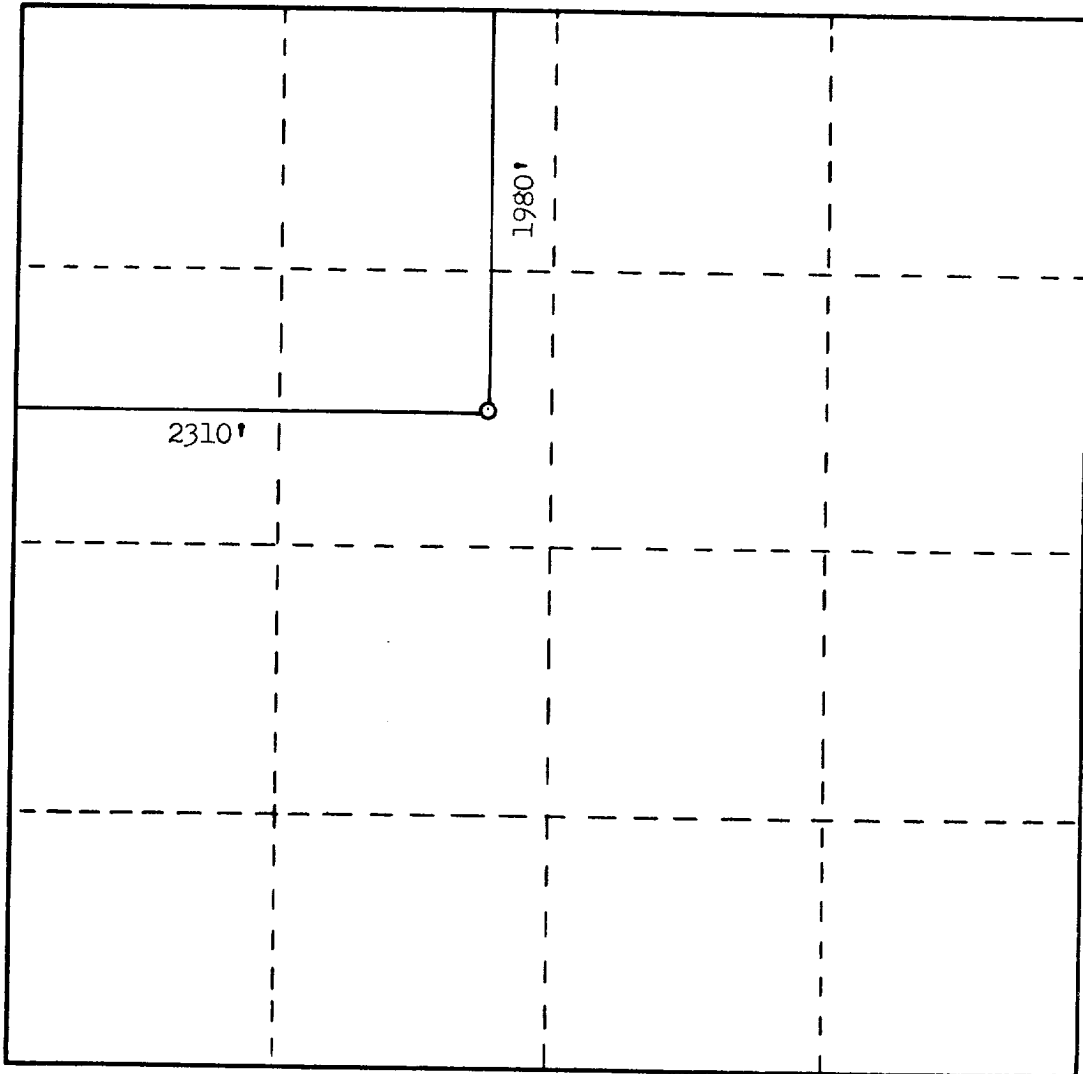
