5. Set 35 sack cement plug from 1084' to 1184'.
6. Set 20 sack cement plug from surface to 60'.
7. Erected regulation marker.

Location will be ready for final inspection by October 14, 1964.

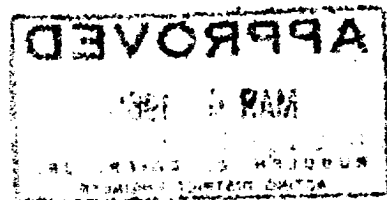
Instructions
