date, and that you had requested that we give you a report on our
operations to date.

I am attachine a copy of a report which I am mailing in triplicate to r. Yarbrough in your Ho bs Office, as r. Yarbrough asked that we clear all reports through that office for transmittal to Banta Fe. This report should explain why there is no drilling rig on the ground at this time. We could not profitable use the cable tool rig further for the reasons mentioned, and as it was a hired rig for the purpose of drilling the surface hole, we allowed him to move for the purpose of drilling the surface hole, we allowed him to move off to other work, and our intentions are to move on our own rotary off to other work, and our intentions are to move on our own rotary rig just as soon as the surface casing can be obtained, which we hope will be within the next few days.
