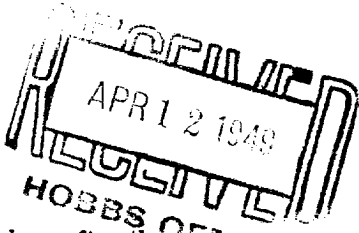

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3925' Total Depth, Lime Ran Temperature survey and found top of cement 3253', 76.1 % Calculated fill. Nippled up 8-5/8" Casing. Went in hole with 7-3/8" bit, found top of cement at 3840'. Tested Casing with 1000# for 30 minutes was O.K. Drilled out cement to 3925', Tested casing with 1000# for 30 mins. was O.K. and started drilling 7-3/8" hole at 8:00 P.M. 4-10-49.
