
Also attached is a water analysis of the Baum Penn Field produced water.

A plat is also included that shows the proposed disposal well and all wells within a two mile radius. This plat shows that only two wells have been drilled deeper than the Permo-Pennsylvanian zone within two miles of the proposed disposal well. They were the Eason Oil Company #2 Wilbo "A" located in the NE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 33 East and the Lawton Oil Company #2 State-Gulf located in the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 33 East. Both wells were Devonian tested and both proved to be wet in the Devonian. All other wells within two miles of the proposed disposal well produce from the Permo-Pennsylvanian formation.

Coastal States respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission approve this administratively; however, if the Commission cannot do this, we request that it be set down for hearing at the next regular hearing date.
