 Tool open 62 minutes with strong blow through 1/8" throughout test.

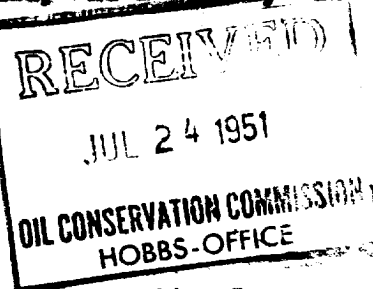
Recovery: 1,000' water cushion, 494.0' oil & gas out drilling mud, and 20' muddy oil as
