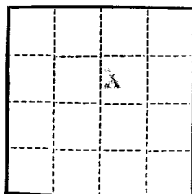

Ran Gamma Ray-Sonic logs. No commercial production encountered. Well plugged and abandoned. Spotted following plugs: 25 sacks @ TD 3015-2900', 25 sacks @ 2600-2560', 25 sacks @ 1150-1050', 35 sacks @ 700-500', 10 sacks @ surface. Set 4" pipe marker.

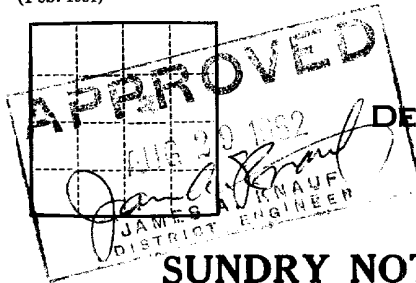

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to an approximate depth of 3000' to attempt a completion in the later horizon. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the USGS, and any special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing patterns: 11" hole, 7 5/8" casing to be set at 550' and cemented with 250 sacks cement. Cement is to circulate. 4 3/4" hole, 3 1/2" casing to be set at 3000' and cemented with 900 sacks cement. Cement is to return to 1500'.

Permission is requested to produce the well upon completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
