DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with Notice of October 4, 1946 well has been plugged and abandoned. Filled with gravel from total depth of 2640' to 2525'; set cement plug from 2525' to 2475' so that plug extended 25' into 5 1/2" casing. Cut and pulled 5 1/2" casing from 2110'; bailed hole after cement plug had set 72 hrs and found bottom water to be shut off. Mudded hole and set 10 sack cement plug on bridge at 915'. Did not cut or pull 8 5/8" spiral weld casing. Set 10 sack cement plug and set at surface and erected 4" by 10' steel marker.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
