Gentlemen:

According to the provisions of Division Order R-8480, effective July 23, 1987, your <u>Southern California Federal Well No. 1</u> located in Unit H of Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico, has been removed from the Lusk-Delaware Pool and placed in the <u>WEST LUSK-DELAWARE POOL</u>.

You are authorized to produce the well without further completion work and you may produce the well at the rate of 100 barrels of oil per day with the excess allowable of 42 barrels per day to be applied to offset the accumulated overproduction.

It is necessary that you submit amended C-115s within 30 days of the effective date of this order.

Please amend your records to show this change in pool designation.
