## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above mentioned well was shot on May 9, 1944 with 140 quarts of Nitro-Glycerin, shooting from 4323' to 4283'. The well when being shot, water was encountered and in shutting off the water the well was plugged back to 4313', using three sacks of cement on bottom and then driving in 1000 pounds of lead wool using 9 feet of cement on top and then there was a complete water shut-off. After swabbing a test was made, ~~flowing 80 barrels of oil in a 4 hour test.~~ flowing 80 barrels of oil in a 4 hour test.
