DETAILS OF WORK

In accordance with notice of intention to repair or re-drill well dated May 2, 1963 and approved May 3, 1963.

The perforations in casing opposite the Queen formation at 3816 to 3836 feet were squeezed with 700 sacks cement. Jet cement set; moved on reverse circulating unit; drilled cement plug out; tested complete shut-off; drilled bridging plug out at 4000 feet; cleaned hole to 11 of 4615 feet. Work completed July 10th, 1963 and put to producing by pumping on same date.

Well tested on July 17th 1963 and produced 10 bbls. oil and 10 bbls. water.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
