DETAILS OF WORK

This well had declined in production to a point where it was not economical to produce. In September 1955 we cleaned the well, after thorough clean out job it failed to respond, production remained less than 5 barrels daily. We then fractured the well with 20,000 gallons Frac Oil and 20,000 pounds sand. Well failed to respond to Frac treatment, it is for these reasons that we request authority to drill this well from its present depth 3756 ft. to approximately 4300 ft. to the Maljamar Sands, cementing the Red Sand off with a 5 1/2" liner, from bottom of present oil string to total depth, perforating liner at oil zone. This well will be fractured with 20,000 gallons Frac Oil and 20,000 pounds Sand.

This request is being made after having previously discussed this with DISTRICT ENGINEER John A. Frost.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
