DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above mentioned well was tested for a water shut off on October 1, 1943. The 7" casing in the amount of 3960 feet was run on September 28, 1943 cemented with 75 sacks of cement. After letting the cement set 72 hours we drilled the plug and tested for the water shut off which was found to be satisfactory. Drilling is being continued.
