DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Tested 4620' 5 1/2" casing set at 4620' cemented with 150 sacks and squeezed at 1610' with 150 sacks. Tested o.k. Drilled to 4633' and had 5 gallons water per hour, ran spinner survey which showed water caving in perforations at 1610'. Squeezed with 50 gallons of Dowell plastic. Squeeze job failed. Re-squeezed with 50 sacks cement. Tested o.k.
