These wells are being produced into central tank battery at the above location along with production from our State of New Mexico "R" #4 well, State of New Mexico "X" #3 well, and State of New Mexico "Z" wells Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4. Authorization to centralize tank battery was received December 12, 1940, approved by Mr. A. Andreas.
